Master Curved Piecing with the "Many Moons" Quilt Pattern

While solids give it a modern look, big prints in the circles make it's a whole new quilt. Many participants say this exploration of color and fabric is their favorite part! This class is designed for confident beginners to advanced quilters.

Foundation Paper Piecing (FPP) Basics with Hexagon Quilt Blocks

In this class, you'll learn how to stitch fabric onto paper, a technique that stabilizes the fabric, reduces stretch, creates precise piecing with sharp points, and creates consistently sized blocks. FPP also allows you to create shapes that would be difficult or impossible to make with traditional methods. I'll guide you through this technique step by step - no prior FPP experience required! You'll be making beautiful hexagon blocks with one of the three pattern options: "Striped Hexi's," "Equilateral Gone Awry," or "Nuts About You". This class is perfect for open minded quilters of all skill levels ready to add a new technique to their repertoire. **Bonuses:** Block design exploration and a special trick to make Y seams a breeze.

Reverse Appliqué with the "Mini Moons" Quilt Pattern

Unlock the magic of reverse appliqué with the charming "Mini Moons" quilt pattern—a miniature twist on our best-selling "Many Moons" design! Using traditional piecing methods for such small circles would be tricky but reverse appliqué simplifies the process. Using just a bit of freezer paper and Elmer's school glue, you'll learn to create smooth, flawless curves effortlessly. Bring along a fun charm pack to showcase in the circles, or opt for solid fabrics for a sleek, modern look. Join us and discover how easy and enjoyable mastering small curves can be! Anyone familiar with basic sewing techniques will thrive in this class.

"All Together Now" - Block of the Month Starter Class

With 32 hexagon blocks to choose from and its incredible borders, you'll fall in love with creating the "All Together Now" quilt. In this class, I'll teach you everything you need to start and complete this stunning quilt. During this introductory session, you'll make the first and simplest block as I guide you through the essential steps and tools of foundation paper piecing (FPP). You'll also learn how to assemble the blocks and put the entire quilt top together. Following the included 8-session schedule, you can continue building your quilt block by block, applying the skills you've gained from session one. Session after session, you'll grow more confident in your FPP abilities, enjoy the camaraderie of your quilting friends, and ultimately, you'll have a beautiful quilt that you'll be proud to showcase! This class is best for intermediate to advanced quilters.

INSTRUCTOR FEES

- · Lecture/Trunk Show: \$350, 60-90 minutes with slides & quilts
- Full-Day Workshop: \$650, 6 hours
- · Half Day Workshop: \$450, 3 hours
- Two Half Day Workshops: \$700, on the same day
- Workshops can accommodate up to 20 students. Additional students beyond 20, up to a total of 30, are charged at \$15 per additional student. Lectures/trunk shows have no attendance limit.
- · Minimum engagement for events outside the Las Vegas area includes a lecture/trunk show and a full day workshop or two half day workshops.

ACCOMMODATIONS

- Expenses for meals, hotel lodging, and travel must be covered for bookings outside the Las Vegas area. I am happy to book my own airfare, travel, and hotel accommodations.
- To estimate the airfare costs, please refer to rates from Las Vegas, Nevada (LAS). Travel costs include airfare, baggage fees, shipping quilts, and any other non-specified incidentals.
- · I will drive to locations within 350 miles of Las Vegas. \$20 per hour for travel time or current per diem rate per mile.
- · Meals are charged at \$50 per day including travel days.
- · Hotel costs average \$150 per night unless specified otherwise.

VENUE REQUIREMENTS

- Provide a projector & screen (or HDMI TV) along with electricity and extension cords for trunk shows/lectures.
- · Provide a table to display and sell my patterns and products.
- · Provide tables to display quilts for lectures/trunk shows.

CONTRACT DETAILS

- · Specifies dates and fees for the event, including travel.
- A \$250 non-refundable deposit is due within 30 days of signed contract; applied toward the balance of the engagement.
- · Travel fees (airfare, hotel, etc.) are non-refundable due to cancellation of the event by the host.
- · Balance of fees are due the day of the event.
- · I will have my patterns and products available for purchase during the event; be sure to schedule a venue that allows selling.
